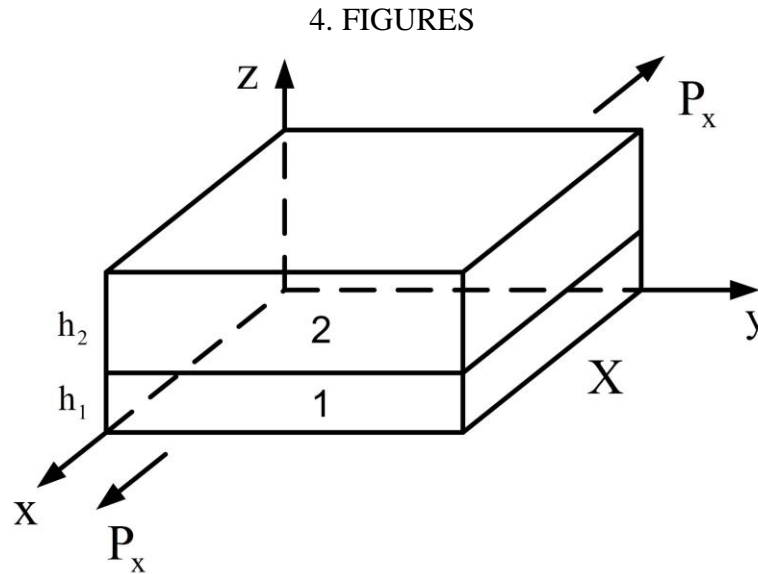

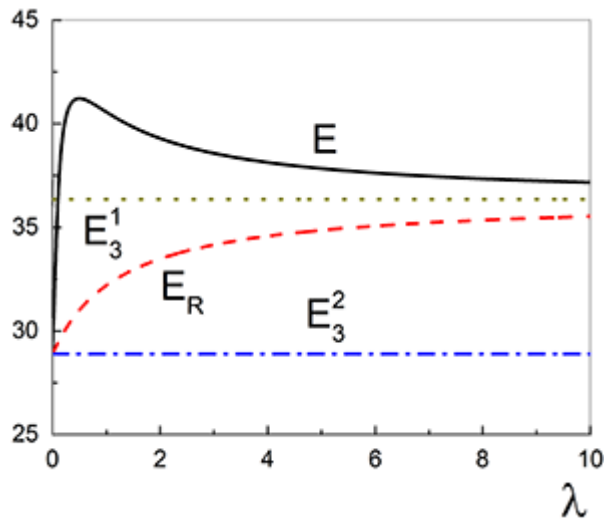
Formulas are recommended to be typed in Equation Editor or MathType.

Aligning formulas is recommended using tabs (8.5 cm is centered for the formula itself, 17 cm is right-aligned for the number).

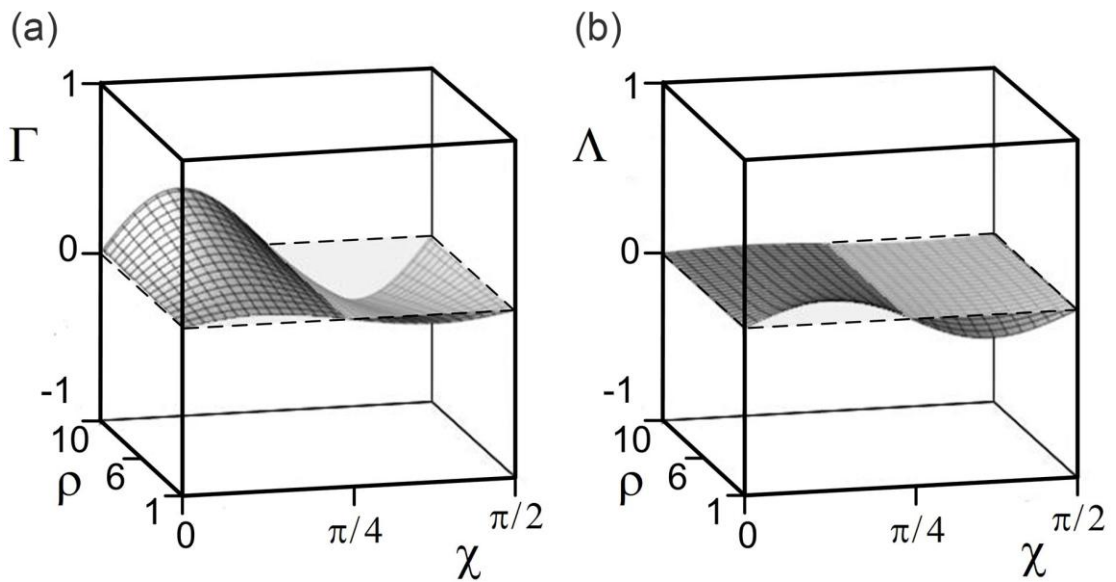


**Fig.1.** Caption
